

Toy Donation Guidelines

Many thanks for making a big difference to the kids we serve in our hospitals and clinics. Prior to making a donation, please be mindful of the following guidelines:

- All donated items must be new (store-bought and in original packaging) and may not contain
 Latex
- Donations with religious or violent themes are not accepted
- Infection control guidelines DO not permit us to accept: gently used items, items that have been stored for an extended period of time and food
- To respect the privacy of our patients and families, we are unable to accept donors personally delivering gifts to patients
- For storage reasons, infection control parameters, equitable distribution and transportation logistics, please keep items to a "grab and go" size (not larger than 12" tall)
- All donations not purchased via Children's Wisconsin's gift registries must be approved by the Volunteer Services Donation Coordinator and dropped off by appointment only.

Items That Will Be Declined

- Beanie babies
- McDonald's Happy Meal toys
- Vending machine toys
- Dollar store items
- Skateboards
- Outdoor activities (skateboards, pogo sticks, water toys, etc.)
- Beauty items: lotion, lip balm, nail polish, make up
- Crocheted/knit blankets
- Completed greeting cards
- Hats
- Pillowcases
- Trading cards/sports cards
- Comic books
- Scented toiletries
